
Plan 1

- **Basically the hatched areas (three-dimensional) on this drawing can be used for exhibition.
- * As picture rails are installed, picture frames may be exhibited by the use of wires or the like.
- *As lighting ducts are installed, lighting equipment may be used. Because these lighting ducts are shared, usable power capacity may be limited.
- *The areas are enclosed with floors, walls and ceilings, but have no entrance doors and are exposed to outside air.

Floor: Stone pitching

Wall: Painted plasterboard


Ceiling: Painted concrete

Ceiling: Painted plasterboard (partly painted steel)


Remark: Glass on the northern side

- *Basically this drawing shows the exact area available for exhibition,

but the details may be changed slightly for the owner's convenience. However, the area will not be changed dramatically.

- *As the venue is located in the vicinity of a subway station, noise and vibration from traveling trains may be felt.
- * Background music in the underground shopping arcade cannot be eliminated.
